___ **“I choose not to take any IB exams.”**

JUNIORS may take up to two IB exams during May of their junior year. The remainder must be taken during the senior year May exam sessions. If you are a Diploma candidate, you pay for the rest of your senior exams during your senior year (NOT this year). It is not possible to take a Higher Level (HL) exam during your junior year because Higher Level exams are offered only for subjects you’ve taken two years at the IB level (e.g. History, English, either Physics or Biology). Theatre Arts and Visual Arts, whether Higher Level or Standard Level, are taken during the senior year.

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Complete this form, sign it and date it, and have a parent or guardian sign it and date it. **Return the form to the IB office by Wednesday, October 23, 2013.**
2. You will receive a printout of registration details and an invoice that you can check for accuracy, sign and date, and return to the IB coordinator no later than **Friday, November 1, 2013.**
3. Go to the bookkeeper, Donna DeLuca, and pay for the total of exam costs on the invoice you received (you can also pay earlier by determining the cost using the fees listed on the back). **The final deadline for payment for exams is Friday, November 1, 2013.** Please be aware that *the IBO does not offer full refunds for exam fees paid.*
4. Take the payment receipt to the IB office and the coordinator will complete an online registration form for your order.
5. Please review your personal details and the subjects for which you are registered with great care. **Notify the coordinator with any changes BEFORE November 15, 2013.** Extra fees occur past this date.

2013-14 EXAM FEES

There are two categories of juniors who take IB exams: **Anticipated candidates** and **Course candidates**. Anticipated candidates are those juniors who intend to earn the IB Diploma by completing all Diploma requirements and taking exams in six subject areas over two years. Course candidates are those juniors who are choosing to take some exams in specific areas but not intending to earn an IB Diploma. They will receive certificates from the IBO (International Baccalaureate Organization) for the subjects in which they take an exam.

3. FOR FUTURE REFERENCE: For future Diploma candidates only

IBO typically raises the fees several dollars each year in each category, but the costs for Diploma candidates below give you an idea of what you can expect to pay during your senior year in order to attempt the full Diploma - the exact amount you will pay then depends upon how many tests you take during your junior year and the amount of increase in fees.

Diploma Candidate - all 6 exams during senior year	\$855
Diploma Candidate - 5 exams during senior year; 1 exam taken junior year	\$590
Diploma Candidate - 4 exams during senior year; 2 exams taken junior year	\$482
